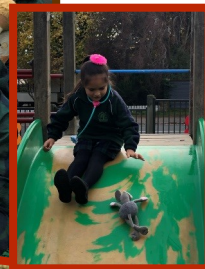

### Teacher Only Day - Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July (last day of term)

We are planning to have a teacher only day to gather the whole teaching team here back together, face to face, for the first time since lockdown to get ready for the Term 3 programme. We are very aware that you do not need to have your children off school again too soon, we also know that the children are showing signs of being tired at the moment and that by 3<sup>rd</sup> July they will have been learning both face to face and online for 14 weeks with only the 4 day Easter break in between.

I am also mindful that the roads will be extremely busy on the first day of the **school term break (Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> July - Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July)** as people get away to parts of New Zealand. We have therefore planned a teacher only day for the last day of term (**Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> July**) to allow you to get on the road ahead of the traffic early if you need to. If you need childcare for the day the YMCA will be running their holiday programme in the school hall from Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July - Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July. ### Staggered Finish from 2.30 pm

We will keep the staggered finish of 2.30 pm, 2.40 pm, 2.50 pm and 3.00 pm until the end of Term 2. By then we will have your survey feedback on how we go forward for the rest of the year.

### Community/Principals Awards re-starting

We are going to re-start our whole school community assemblies in the school hall from next **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June at 2 pm** unless something significant happens over the coming week. Parents are very welcome to attend.

## The Hunt is over, it's time to celebrate!

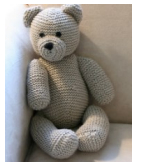

Before you register please make sure your team is aware of the following:-

- The Pavilion will be closed

- Only outside toilets will be available. No changing rooms.

- There will be no food or drinks on sale. Bring your own drink bottles.

- You must provide your own ball, bibs and whistles

- We recommend where possible you do not bring spectators or children

Rose (Rotorua netball) will do training for the signing in for team and group codes after all registrations are received. Training will be **MONDAY/WEDNESDAY** for the first two weeks.

Return to Community Hockey Guideline - Rotorua Hockey Association

Now that we are in Alert Level 2, community hockey can commence but only if strict health measures are met. What does this mean for hockey in Rotorua?

**Phase 1** - Getting ready to train

From the 12<sup>th</sup> May all hockey organisations have entered a "Get Ready to Train" Phase. There is a significant amount of planning and work required to get our facility ready so we meet Health & Safety and contact tracing requirements.

**Phase 2** - Prepare to play (training)

Rotorua Hockey will enter a "prepare to play phase" sometime between 25<sup>th</sup> May and 1<sup>st</sup> June. This would coincide with a hopeful easing in mass gathering restrictions. After the 1<sup>st</sup> June we are expecting to be able to recommence allowing athletes and teams to prepare themselves for competition. Turf bookings will not be taken for dates before this time.

**Phase 3** - Return to play (competition)

This stage will not commence until the current mass gathering restrictions have been lifted.

NZ Hockey has indicated that from 13<sup>th</sup> June competition can recommence pending the announcement on increasing the mass gathering restrictions.

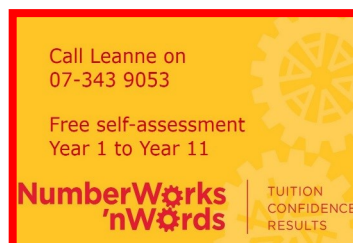
