# FROM THE PRINCIPAL ...

It's been a tricky week with the new concerns about Covid-19 in the country. We are trying to carry on as normally as we can, it is important that the students are not stressed about anything they may hear around in the media. Not a huge amount has changed at Level 2, we have a renewed push to keep hand washing and sanitising as a priority and ensuring we stay on top of the most recent information. We all know how quickly things can change, we will be keeping you in the loop via all of our communication tools. (The school website, the SeeSaw App, the Lynmore School App). If you need any help downloading or using any of the communication tools ask your child's teacher, ring us or drop into the office anytime.

## **Please:**

- ♦ Do not let your child attend school if they are sick
- ♦ Download the Covid -19 app. and use it to scan into venues
- ♦ Join Lakes DHB Facebook Page for accurate community health updates
- ♦ Note that distance learning will take place should we move to Level 3 or 4 only as our teachers are teaching in class currently distance learning is not available at level 2.
- ♦ Download the school app <https://apps.apple.com/nz/app/schoolappsNZ/id1299777519>
- ♦ Check the See Saw app for class and schoolwide updates
- ♦ Look on the front page of the school website for updates [www.lynmore.school.nz](http://www.lynmore.school.nz)
- ♦ Use the Covid -19 testing centre at 2, Vaughan Road (cnr Te Ngae and Vaughan Roads) if you need a test for Covid.
- ♦ Make your own decisions about school attendance at Level 2 depending on how you as a family feel in relation to your own children. School is fully open but any absentees will be considered justified at level 2.
- ♦ Talk to your children about hand washing / hand sanitising

## **Community Assembly this week (Friday 2pm – 3 pm):**

Is going ahead but with reduced numbers in the hall. The fabulous Room 8 have their class item on the stage and Principals awards will go ahead as normal.

The senior school students plus the principal award recipients are the only students who will be physically present in the school hall on Friday. Parents of children receiving awards or from Room 8 are welcome to attend in person. Note: the restrictions on social gatherings at Level 2 do not apply to schools (bizarre, but true)

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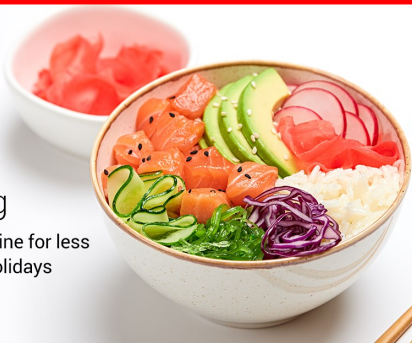
