FROM THE PRINCIPAL ...

Community Assembly this week (Friday 2.00pm – 3.00pm)...

is going ahead but with reduced numbers in the hall. The fabulous Room 16 have their class item on the stage and Principals awards will go ahead as normal.

The middle school students plus the Principal Awards recipients are the only students who will be physically present in the school hall on Friday. Parents of children receiving awards, or from Room 16 are welcome to attend in person. Note: the restrictions on social gatherings at Level 2 do not apply to schools (bizarre, but true).

Astroturf and New Fencing;

We are very fortunate to have new funding for new astroturf to be installed over the next term break. We are also aware we need to replace the fencing around the turf but at this stage can't afford it.

We need to raise \$54k to replace the fencing and **have had a fantastic idea put forward on how we might be able to raise the money for new fencing.**

We are going to be open to sponsoring sections of the fencing e.g. you will be able to buy space on the perimeter fence to advertise your business. The fence is likely to stay there for 15 – 20 years so it will be a great advertising opportunity. The current Astroturf advert by the side of Te Ngae road has been there for 18 years – not a bad return for the cost of a sign. There will be a separate notice coming out on how you can buy a space on the brand new fence next to the brand new astroturf. Thanks again for all the amazing suggestions.



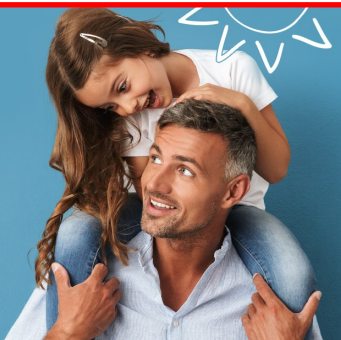

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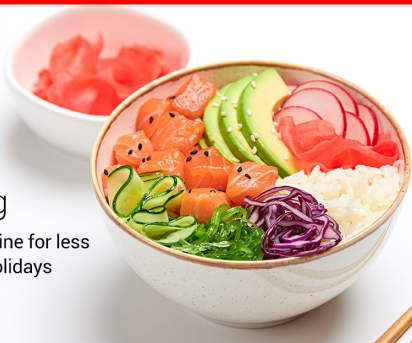
