# FROM THE PRINCIPAL ...

## Welcome back!

It is great to be back and during a very difficult year for everyone it is reassuring to be back at Level 1 and able to run the school as near to normal as possible. **Community assembly** runs every Friday 2.00 pm – 3.00 pm in the school hall – everyone is very welcome to attend.

It is a 9 week term and school finishes for the summer break on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> December at 3 pm. We have a very busy few weeks ahead and are beginning the process of student class placements. Where possible we will keep your child with their 2020 teacher for a second year. If they have already had their current teacher for 2 years they are likely to have a different one in 2021. We have a very stable staffing situation and at this stage we will have no new staff to the school for 2021. If you have particular questions or concerns for 2021 please contact the classroom teacher, Mr Cunliffe, Mrs C-T or myself by email so that we can try to meet your needs.

As it is now Term 4 we have swimming and children also must have a sunhat to wear. You can purchase the **school uniform hat from the office for \$12**. Thank you.

## Walking/Wheels Wednesdays – Term 4

We will be **closing the drop off zone EVERY WEDNESDAY from next week (week 2)** and running a walking and wheels to school day. We are trying to encourage more children to walk and ride to school where they can. The congestion outside the school, particularly at the end of the day is becoming dangerous. We are working closely with the District Council, NZTA and the Police to come up with some safe alternatives for children and parents. We will be as part of this work developing 3 to 4 new walking routes from 3 key starting points in the community. This was based on the feedback from the community survey in Term 1 this year which asked residents to identify safe and not so safe areas for walking and cycling.

## Drop off in the mornings and YMCA before school cover

Please ensure your children don't arrive at school before 8.00am each day. The classrooms are locked until 8.15am as teachers need time to get their classrooms and lessons prepared from 7.15am onwards. It is very cold in the mornings and we are worried about children who spend an hour in the cold before school starts. The YMCA offer a fantastic **service in the hall before and after school**. 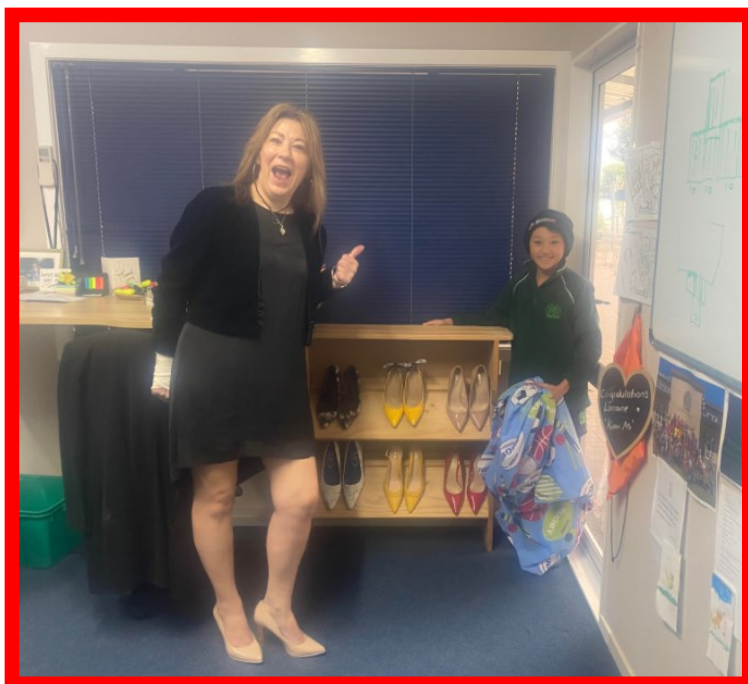
To **Candice Chen** (Room 17, Year 3) who attended the Rotorua Dance Competition on 1st October, and got several awards and trophies for her ballet performance:

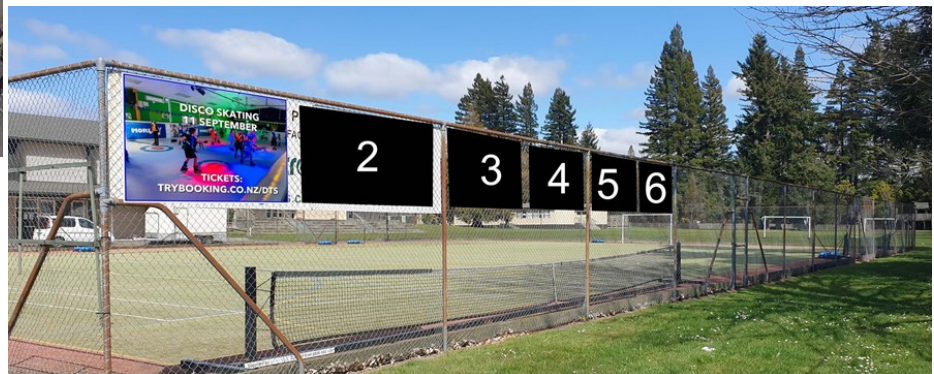
## Sponsor the Fence - Update

We are replacing the sports surface (AstroTurf) and the surrounding fencing, both are over 20 years old. The combined cost of replacement of both is around \$170k.

We need to raise around \$55k to enable us to complete the entire project including:

- Removing some of the trees that drop leaves onto the AstroTurf along side Te Ngae Road.
- Replacing the fence

Once the new fencing is in place and some of the obscuring trees removed the two sides marked below have a great advertising opportunity along Te Ngae Road and Iles Road. We are therefore selling the option of an advertising space along the new fencing around the AstroTurf.

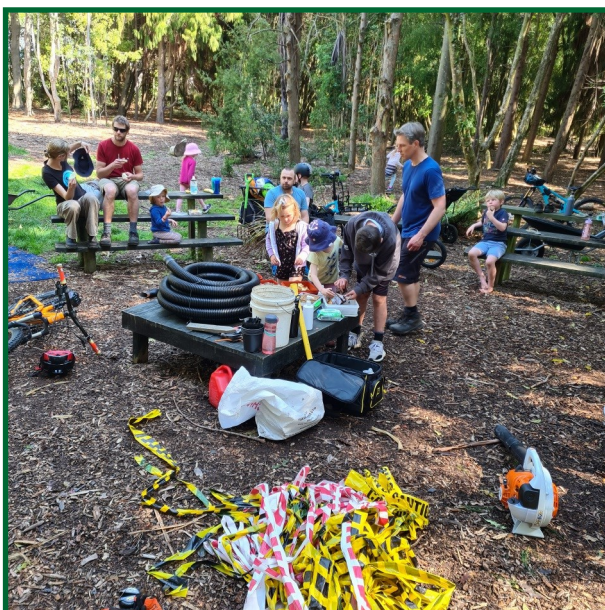

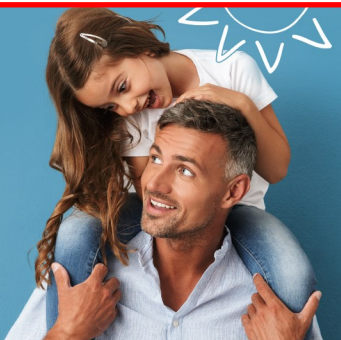

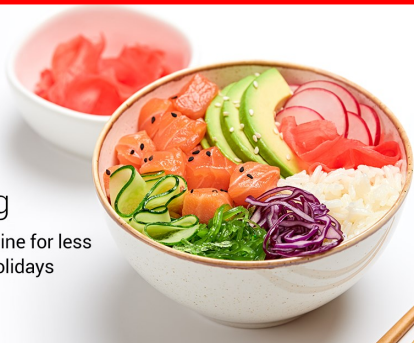
