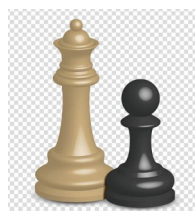

New school class structure from 2021 (Whare Ako)

Many, many thanks to everyone who was able to attend one of the information meetings on Tuesday about the proposed new way of structuring classes, year groups and teams from next year. We have been overwhelmed by the supportive and positive comments and we are looking forward to being able to offer more flexibility and choice for you as parents in terms of your child's 2021 class placement. Your child's teacher will be sending out the Whare Ako (as we are calling our new structure) information sheet via SeeSaw this week and for those of you who were unable to attend the information meetings we will have a short video available online next week.

Innovative Streets Project

This involves looking at a variety of traffic calming solutions and better access for cyclists and pedestrians on Iles, Owhatiura, Larcy Roads and the school drop off zone. You can read more about this project at: www.nzta.govt.nz/roads-and-rail/innovating-streets/about/pilot-fund

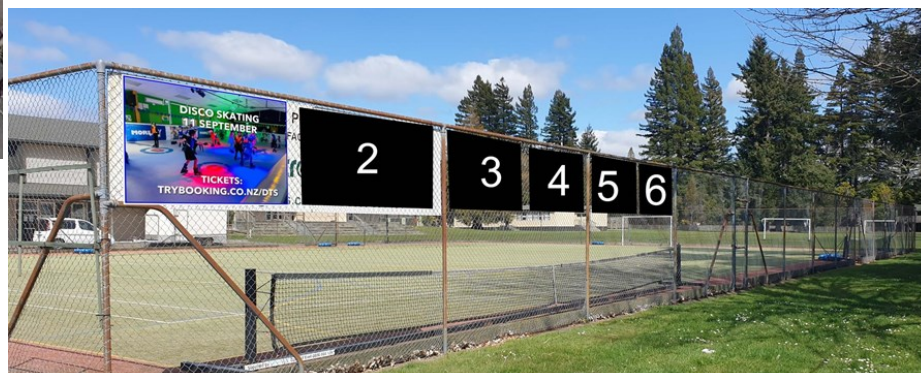
Sponsor the Fence - Update

We are replacing the sports surface (AstroTurf) and the surrounding fencing, both are over 20 years old. The combined cost of replacement of both is around \$170k.

We need to raise around \$55k to enable us to complete the entire project including:

- Removing some of the trees that drop leaves onto the AstroTurf along side Te Ngae Road.
- Replacing the fence

Once the new fencing is in place and some of the obscuring trees removed the two sides marked below have a great advertising opportunity along Te Ngae Road and Iles Road. We are therefore selling the option of an advertising space along the new fencing around the AstroTurf.



Costs for advertising signage for a 2 year timeframe are as follows:

Te Ngae Road side:

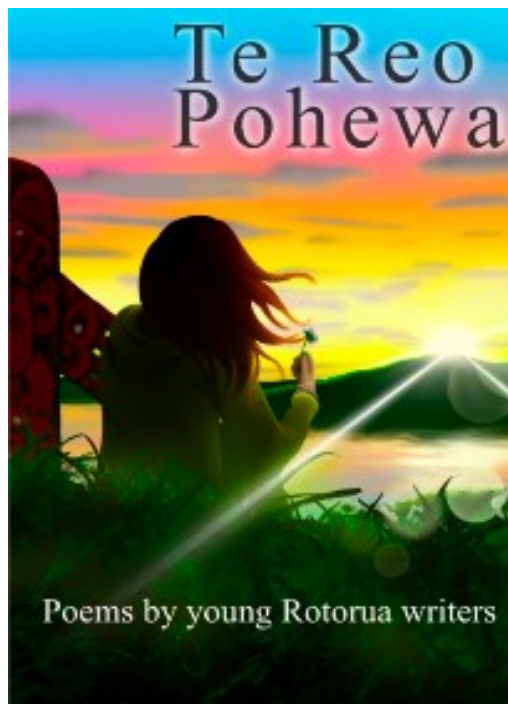
CONGRATULATIONS

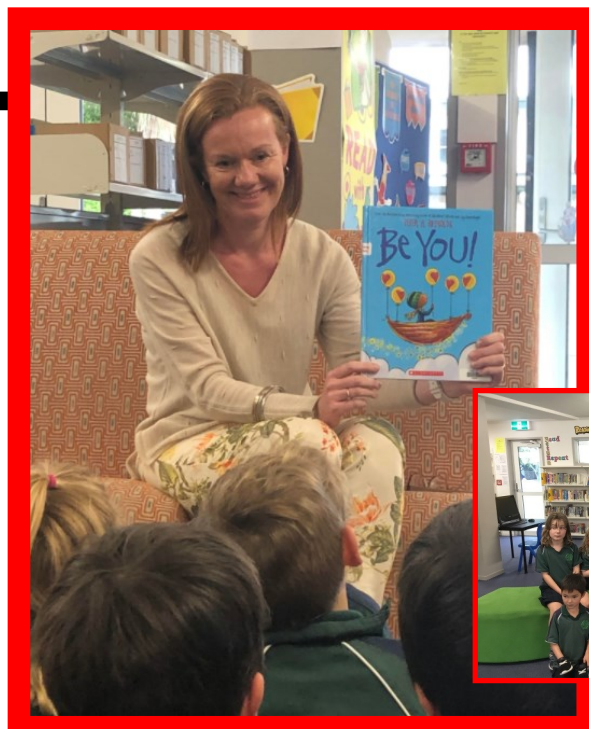

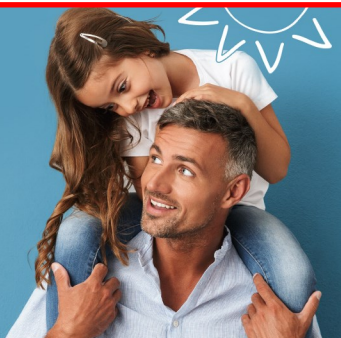

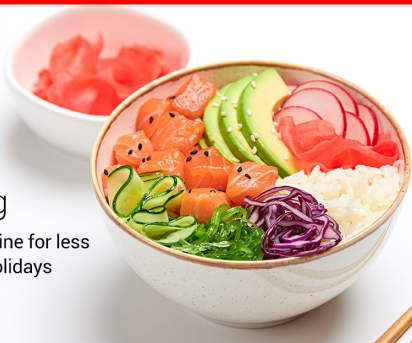
