FROM THE PRINCIPAL ...

2021 Class Placements:

We have just 2 weeks of the school year to go and are in the process of placing children into classrooms for the 2021 year. If you are moving out of the area and leaving Lynmore School please let us know as soon as you can so that we can reallocate your school place to someone else.

Sickness at school:

We have large numbers of children being sent to school with sickness and tummy bugs as a consequence we have increasing numbers of teachers off sick after catching colds, tummy bugs etc. **PLEASE** do keep your children home if they are sick. I know it's really tricky to get time off from work etc. but the domino effect is that we then have sickness running through entire classes for 3 weeks or so and teachers off sick from work. It also means your children have relievers in their class instead of their regular teacher, it costs the school \$300 per day for every reliever we employ – some days this term we have had 7 or 8 relievers in due to sickness. If we can break the chain of tummy bugs and colds it would really help everyone. Many thanks.

Astroturf Replacement:

The new Astroturf and fencing is nearly finished – it should be ready to use by the end of next week. We are however changing the use of the Astroturf from the end of this year. We have had ongoing problems with vandalism and glass on the Astroturf after weekends and during the summer months. Once the new fencing and turf is in we will be running a bookings process similar to the gym and not have it open to the general public. We are also installing security cameras on the turf to try to reduce the amount of damage we sustain. The cost of the upgrade was around \$180k and it is money we won't have again to fix any damage. Many thanks for your support with this. Details on how to book the turf over the summer will come out next week.

Kapa Haka Ahurei Tickets 2020:

We are excited to be taking part in the 2020 schools Kapa Haka event next week at the Energy Events Centre. Te Kura o Owhatirua – Lynmore School is performing on Thursday evening 3rd December at 6.30 pm. A letter is coming out today to all whanau with students performing next week to order tickets. Tickets are \$9 each and if you have a child over 2 years old you do have to purchase a ticket for them due to fire regulations in the Events Centre. At this stage we have just 100 tickets allocated to Lynmore School so we are initially limiting tickets to 2 per whanau. You can also purchase a ticket from Mokoia Intermediate if you have another whanau member performing for them as they are on the same night as us.

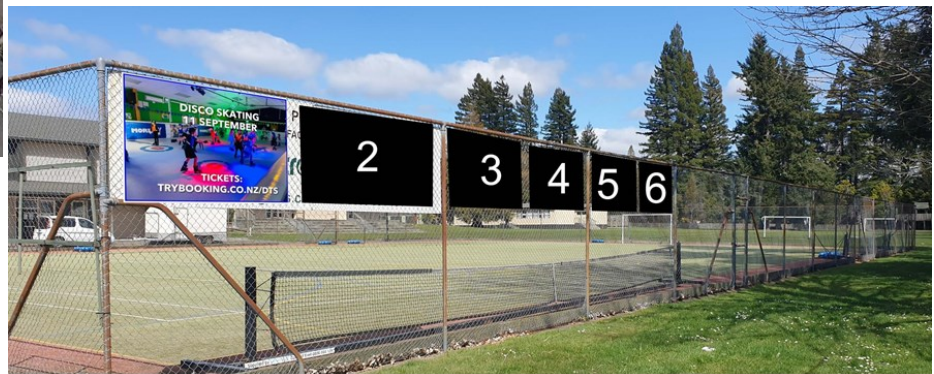
Sponsor the Fence - Update

We are replacing the sports surface (AstroTurf) and the surrounding fencing, both are over 20 years old. The combined cost of replacement of both is around \$170k.

We need to raise around \$55k to enable us to complete the entire project including:

- Removing some of the trees that drop leaves onto the AstroTurf along side Te Ngae Road.
- Replacing the fence

Once the new fencing is in place and some of the obscuring trees removed the two sides marked below have a great advertising opportunity along Te Ngae Road and Iles Road. We are therefore selling the option of an advertising space along the new fencing around the AstroTurf.

Bake Sale

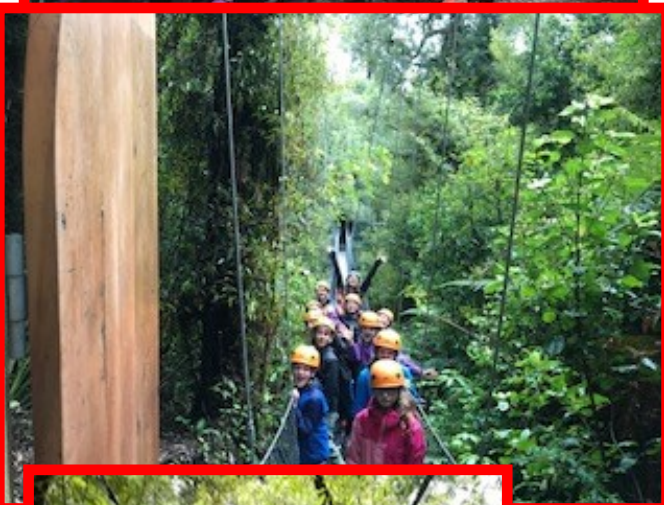

The Bay of Plenty Rugby Union and Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology have partnered together to create the High-Performance Rugby Pathway (HPRP) delivered in three locations; Rotorua, Whakatane and Tauranga.

The HPRP is a one-year programme aimed at young athletes. The programme is designed to improve rugby athletes' self-development in the areas of nutrition, exercise physiology, performance testing, sports psychology, and sport technology while formally studying for the Level Certificate in Exercise, and Certificate in Freestyle Group Exercise qualifications from Toi Ohomai.

The HPRP programme is being delivered in three locations to enable athletes to remain close to home, and support rugby in their communities. The Bay of Plenty Rugby Union is committed to growing community rugby, so selection preference will be given to athletes who share this commitment.
